OXYGEN CHURCH PLANTER Ottawa

BACKGROUND

Oxygen Church was planted in 2021 as a satellite campus of Community Pentecostal Church. With the realities of Covid and lockdowns, Oxygen was forced to launch on-line. There was a great viewership until the summer of 2021. Oxygen continued online, but started an in-person expression at Vanier Community Church, approximately 2km from the University of Ottawa. It was averaging somewhere around 40 people weekly. With the rise of Omicron, volunteers were impacted causing Oxygen to go back online. After many challenges due to Covid, the lead pastor of Oxygen stepped down, causing the plant to be paused until leadership could be found.

GOAL

Oxygen was created to provide a church for university students (primarily) and young professionals (secondary) in the area of the University of Ottawa and the Byward Market.

NEW APPROACH

Oxygen will become a church plant, overseen and invested in by a collaboration of PAOC churches in Ottawa. The goal would be to establish Oxygen as a self-governing church upon establishing a sustainable financial base.

- Establish a presence on the University of Ottawa
- Oversee a team of volunteers in establishing a church expression weekly
- Organize social justice initiatives to tie university students into Oxygen

- Work with PAOC churches in Ottawa in the development of Oxygen
